Kay Hope is a managing director and leads Bank of America's fixed income research effort on sustainability issues globally. She is also a corporate credit analyst focusing on emerging market names across sectors, mainly in the CIS, Sub-Saharan Africa and Israel. Her team ranked number 1 for ESG when the category launched in the 2021 Institutional Investor Research Team survey, and she remained in the top position in 2022-24. She also ranked number 1 in EEMEA Corporate Debt as a team and/or individually in the 2016-24 surveys (she was number 3 in the All-Russia surveys in 2014-15).

Prior to joining the firm in 2010, Hope held emerging market roles at Goldman Sachs, Deutsche Bank and Credit Suisse First Boston. She also spent several years at McKinsey & Company in Moscow and a year in Almaty, Kazakhstan, working for an international aid organisation.

She holds an MBA from Columbia Business School, a master's degree in Soviet foreign policy from Harvard Graduate School of Arts and Sciences and a bachelor's degree in Slavic literature from the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor. She is based in London.
